Blog used as an (e)portfolio Portfolio: a purposeful collection of pupils' work that tells the story of a pupil's achievement and growth in one or more areas over time. Using blogs as an eportfolio... • For Chinese Language writing - A study conducted in 2004 - 2 classes of Sec 3 express students - A 'replacement' for newspaper articles reflection exercise (剪报)

Some findings ...

- Portfolio Building in Chinese Language Learning Using Blogs (Tan, Teo, Aw & Lim, 2005)
 - ICT vs 'traditional' mode
 - more interesting than the traditional newspaper cutting book
 - felt a greater sense of ownership over the portfolio than the traditional newspaper cutting book

 - believed they are able to improve on their own reviews after reading friends' reviews
 - felt encouraged when they see others post positive comments to their blogs

Not just text and pictures In another study - Audioblogging: Supporting the Learning of Oral Communication Skills in Chinese Language (Tan, Ow & Tan, 2006) • conducted in a primary school, 3 classes of CL students • voice recording (audio files) in blog posts - captured with portable mp3 players Nanyang Girls' High School Dec 27 2006
